Music Summary:

Sam was awarded an internal Scholarship grant in 2014, which he will putting to use this year.

He completed his Cambridge A Level Music at the end of last year with the schools highest marks (2nd year in a row). He has decided to continue to study Music in 2015 with his main focus on composing, song-writing and producing.

Over the past 12 months Sam has been working with the School Senior Orchestra and as a result they have been performing in the world of classic crooners – such as Michael Buble, Frank Sinatra and others. This has provided him an opportunity to showcase his abilities in a new genre and has gained him many more fans along the way. In fact some of Sam's fans have debated this could be his best genre yet.

Outside of school he has been working with legendary Producer Vince Harder and together they have created an impressive library of 4 radio-ready songs over the past year.

His own personal genre is classic soul and R&B – and his music releases reflect this.
